# Annual Report (2023-24)

SD Public School Hamirpur aims to be the pioneer in educational institutions dedicatedly committed towards nurturing and fostering eminence. We at SDPS take immense pleasure and pride to present the annual report of our activities and achievements for the past one year i.e. 2022-23.

### **Brief History of the School**

This school was established in the year 2005 and simultaneously affiliated to H.P. Board of School education Dharamsala. Gradually, with the limited sources of income, the school has created adequate infrastructure to accommodate 2000 students to impart quality education. At present, it is functioning as English Medium, coeducational school and running classes from Pre-primary to 10+2 level (Science stream). The school has successfully completed 18 sessions and presently 19<sup>th</sup> is going on.

### Our vision:

But a task with a vision can change the world. Our vision at SDPS is to turn mirrors into windows where we get to see the brighter side thus removing ignorance, fear and making a society of rationalists and humanists.

### Our motto:

The motto of our school is, "Education for Perfection". Our ultimate aim is to impart quality education for all-round development of the children to make them sensible citizen of this country. We further want to promote a scientific temperament amongst the children to keep pace with the developing world.

### Our mission:

At SDPS, we perceive to inspire and enthuse children to develop them into well rounded, confident and responsible individuals who aspire to achieve their full potential. We give them a pre eminent, intellectual and a creative centre for their growth.

### **Establishment Statement:**

To achieve our objectives, the school has dedicated team of teaching and non-teaching staff. In order to achieve its goal, the school has **125 staff –members** whose detail is as under: -

It is pertinent to mention here that teaching staff is appointed by the school administration after proper screening test, interviews and close scrutiny of academic and professional qualifications. Initial appointment is made provisionally for a period of one year and thereafter the confirmation is made after the satisfaction of the administration. Our entire teaching staff is proficient and dedicated to the profession. At present eleven hundred students are getting quality education in this school, and everything is going on as per the norms of Indian Education system.

### **School Results & Other Highlights: -**

These are as under: -

- 1. <u>In 12<sup>th</sup> std.</u>, Ishant Rana S/O Sh. Krishan Chand got 95.20% marks. 12 students got more than 90% marks and 44 students got more than 80% marks. Maximum children got admission in reputed professional colleges.
- 2. <u>In 10<sup>th</sup> std.,4 students grab their position in the Merit list in the session 2022-23.</u> 48 students got more than 90% marks and 31 students got more than 80% marks.
- 3. 07 students of 10<sup>th</sup> std. and 09 students of 12<sup>th</sup> std. have been selected for Swami Viveka Nand Utkrisht Chhatervriti Yojna and 12 students are selected for Dr. Ambedker Medhavi Chhatervriti Yojna.
- 4. Digital teaching from classes 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> std. is going on very effectively.
- 5. Sainik School Coaching classes on demand are running in the school campus effectively. Besides, we are also facilitating Competitive Coaching Classes for 9<sup>th</sup> onwards students.
- 6. Telephonically, we are in regular touch with the parents of weak students.

### **Co-Curricular Activities: -**

Education does not merely comprise of theoretical knowledge. It is the process of emancipation and all-round development of an individual. Keeping this in view, our school is participating in all co-curricular activities as are organized in the school and also represented in Block, Distt. & State level events convened from time to time. The brief detail of such participation and our achievements are appended below: - Sports Activities: -

- (i) <u>In District Level (U-19) Boxing Championship (Boys)</u>, our three students got Gold medals, one student got Silver medal and two students got Bronze medal. In state level Ayush won Bronze medal. In Boxing Championship (Girls) Saniya got Gold medal.
- (ii) <u>In Distt. Level (U-19) Wrestling Championship,</u> our one student, Suraj Thakur won Bronze medal.
- (iii) <u>In District Level (Open Tournament)</u> Boxing championship Aryan Patiyal got Bronze medal, Saniya got Gold medal and she is also selected for State Level.
- (iv) <u>In District level (U-8, U- 12, U-16 and U 18)</u> Open Athletic meet, our one student got Gold medal, 3 got Silver medals and 3 got Bronze medals in Running and Standing Jump. Prashantveer Thakur won Bronze medal in state level.
- (v) <u>In Kabaddi (U-19)</u>, our Boys team is a winner in Block Level Tournament & comes Runner up in District Level Tournament and our two Kabaddi players; Mr. Prashant Veer Thakur and Mr. Ayush Thakur are selected for State level tournament.
- (vi) <u>In Block Level (U-14)</u> our two girls selected for Distt. Level Tournament. Aradhya Pathania selected for Chess and Sanskriti selected for Kabaddi.

<u>Children Science Congress:</u> - In 31<sup>st</sup>, Children Science Congress 2023, our 13 students took part in different competitions at Block Level. Out of 13, our 4 students selected for District Level competition. In Science Quiz our two students Ms. Irisha and Ms. Anmol in Junior category from 8<sup>th</sup> std. got 2<sup>nd</sup> position. In Mathematical Olympiad in Senior Category Mannat from 10<sup>th</sup> std. secured 2<sup>nd</sup> position and qualified for District Level. In activity corner, from Junior category Navneet Garg from 8<sup>th</sup> std. has selected for best three activities and qualified for the District Level.

### **Special Features of the School**

The school has its own land with appropriate infrastructure to conduct various activities, as desired. The school has the following additional special features to impart model education: -

### (a) Hostel Facility: -

From the session 2020-21our school is providing its "State - of -the -Art" hostel facility for boys and girls.

### (b) <u>Transport Facility</u>: -

School has its own fleet of 12 buses for the convenience of the students at reasonable rates.

### (c) Creation of Four Houses: -

In order to inculcate a competitive spirit, leadership qualities and development of personality, the entire school has been divided into **Four Houses**; named as under:-

(1) Beas House (2) Gomti House (3) Kaveri House (4) Sutlej House

Functioning of each house is managed by House Masters backed by teachers.

### d) Celebration of Festivals: -

Keeping in view the rich values of our society, the school celebrates the main festivals in the school campus to make the children aware of their importance.

(e) <u>NSS Unit</u>: - To teach the students to render selfless services to the community, the school has established NSS Unit and it is working effectively. Time to time the unit organizes camps.

### (f) Scouts & Guides Unit: -

Our school has also established Scouts & Guides unit in which the students participate and learn a lesson of discipline, honesty, unity and integrity of the nation. Through this unit, our students participate in each and every activity which is organized at the Distt. level and State level. Last year our three scouts Ashutosh, Arpit Patial, Aakash and one guide Divya from 12<sup>th</sup> Std. participated in State Level Rajya Purskar Testing Camp which was organized at Riwalsar, Distt. Mandi and qualified for Rastrapati Award. This year our 4 Scouts and 4 Guides participated in TRITIYA SOPAN CAMP which was organised at GSSS Mahal, Distt. Hamirpur. They are qualified for Rajya Puraskar.

### (g) Playway Method & Kindergarten System: -

To cater to the needs and bringing up of tiny tots, school has separate kindergarten wing. Here education is imparted by play way method with the help of proficient and well trained teachers. It is working with complete success and satisfaction of all parents under fully experienced wing incharge.

### (h) Morning Assembly: -

According to the Father of the Nation, "Prayer is the key of the morning and the bolt of the evening". Morning Assembly is the mirror of any academic institution. Keeping in view its importance, the administration has made it a platform of effective communication by including in it personality development programs like news, quiz, debate, speech, topics, moral education and cultural activities. All students of the school participate in these activities impartially (House wise). To enhance G.K., Questions of General awareness are asked by the teachers daily in the morning assembly. The morning assembly is conducted 3 days in English, 2 days in Hindi and one day in Sanskrit language. Exercise is done before the morning assembly daily.

(i) Teaching through digital techniques (6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> std.): - The school is providing teaching through digital techniques. Each and every concept is presented through Power Point Presentation to make teaching-learning process more effective in the class rooms. It is benefiting the students of Elementary, Sec. & Sr. Sec. levels.

### (j) Computer Education: -

Keeping in view the importance of information & technology in the modern era, the administration has introduced compulsory computer education from classes 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> level, whereas, in 10+1 & 10+2, Computer Science subject is optional. In this regard, school has established two well-furnished computer labs which are fully functional with efficient, experienced and well-versed computer teachers with excellent results.

### (l) Scholarships: -

Our school has bagged the following scholarships in the academic excellence in the session 2022-23 as under: -

### (n) Ban on Tuition Culture: -

The tuition culture is totally banned in the academic work in the institution. As it is not required due to our regularity in the teaching work.

### (o) 'Parent-Teacher' Meetings: -

The school periodically organizes 'parent-teacher' meetings where talks are focused on the level of child in different spheres of performance.

### (p) School Website: -

The website contains complete information about the school, staff members and activities. It is regularly maintained and updated to provide the latest information as desired.

### (q) Introduction of Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation System: -

In compliance with the direction of Deptt. of Education, Govt. of Himachal Pradesh and keeping in view its educational value, our institution has also adopted the continuous comprehensive evaluation system for the benefits of children.

### (r) <u>Library</u>: -

Library is the major deptt. in any educational institution. At present we have a good library catering to the needs of students. Apart from text books we are also issuing variety of other good books to the children as well as staff members.

### (s) Health Education: -

We are living in a fast moving world. Most of the time we remain unaware of our health aspect which definitely needs special attention by the teachers and parents of their wards. Keeping in view this important aspect, the school administration has been arranging the services of the qualified doctors/health educators in the school campus itself. Periodical health check-ups have been arranged by the school administration in collaboration with the Zonal Hospital Hamirpur.

### (u) Provision of Parking Place: -

In modern era, the culture of owning own vehicles is on the rise. To fulfill the parking requirement, we have proper and enough parking area just outside the school gate.

- (w) <u>Our Well-Developed New Complex:</u> Our ergonomically designed New Complex has become functional from this Academic Session 2023-24 which is situated amidst the green and serene environment at Dugha Kalan. This complex is equipped with State of the art infrastructure, strengthened sports activities and within campus Hostel facilities for Boys and Girls separately. Games & Sports are very essential activities for the development of the students. Considering it as an important element, our new campus is now providing students more play fields- an important element, which was lacking in the congested premises of old school. Our children are equally involved in fitness activities during school hours under the supervision of our physical education teachers. Our new complex on the outskirts is also providing safety to the students from traffic hazards.
- (x) <u>Plan to switch over to CBSE: -</u> Presently, our school is affiliated to HPBOSE but affiliation with CBSE within next few days is on the way.

### **Future Planning**

Planning is an important aspect of any institution. It is otherwise known as life-line of the institution. Keeping this aspect in mind, the school administration has acquired sufficient infrastructure to accommodate two thousand students. Fully digital teaching is going in the Elementary, Secondary and Sr. Secondary classes.
